1. Does IUOE Local 138 have a registered program with NYDOL? "YES".
2. What is the name of the registered program? "Heavy Equipment Operator" / "Operating Engineer (Heavy Equipment)
3. What tasks in this program are duplicative to any tasks in the new program proposed by Plumbers' Local 200? " The plumbers' proposed "Pump & Tank " program includes several references to the operation of heavy equipment specifically the operation of a backhoe for the excavation & trenching required for the installation of subterranean tanks & connecting pumps. Those duties are part of the existing registered program for heavy equipment operator that currently requires thousands of hours of apprentice training for successful completion.
