Grounds/Maintenance Specialist: 3 fulltime, temporary, seasonal (H-2B) jobs available 2/15/17-11/15/17. Employer: Traditional Landscaping & Design, LLC, 10 Traditional Lane, Loudonville, NY 12211. Duties: Landscape or maintain grounds of property using hand or power tools/equipment. Must be able to perform a variety of tasks without close supervision, which may include any combination of the following: sod laying, mowing, trimming, planting, watering, fertilizing, digging, raking, assists with sprinkler installation and installation of mortarless segmental concrete masonry wall units. Must exercise independent judgment; may be asked to demonstrate tasks to other employees but position does not include supervision of others. Employer to provide transportation to and from worksites in Albany, Saratoga and Schenectady counties. Post-hire random, post-accident and upon suspicion of use drug testing required of foreign or domestic workers. Must be able to lift/carry 50 lbs. Work days: Mon-Fri, 7am-3:30pm, 40 hours/week at \$14.32. Sat/Sun work required, when necessary; OT available at \$21.48/hour. Raises/bonuses may be offered to any worker in the specified occupation, at the company's sole discretion, based on individual factors including work performance, skill and tenure. The worker may be requested to work more than the stated hours per day, depending on weather and other conditions. Extreme heat, cold, rain, or drought may affect exact working hours. No education required; 3 months of experience required. Employer will accept related experience. Employer will provide without charge all tools, supplies and equipment necessary to perform duties assigned. A single workweek will be used to compute wages due. Workers will be paid weekly on Friday. The employer will make all deductions from worker's paycheck required by law. Employer may assist with securing housing if the worker(s) require assistance. Workers will pay landlord directly; housing not paid through payroll deduction. The employer will pay in advance or reimburse H-2B workers for the first workweek for costs incurred by the worker for visa, processing, border crossing, and other related fees, including those mandated by the government (excluding passport fees). For workers outside reasonable commuting distance, transportation (including meals and, to the extent necessary, lodging) to the place of employment will be arranged and provided, if the worker completes half the employment period (50% period), if not already paid in full prior to the 50% period. Return transportation will be provided if the worker completes the employment period or is dismissed early by the employer. Transportation reimbursements shall be calculated on the worker's actual cost but no more than the most economical and reasonable similar common carrier transportation charges for the distance involved. Daily subsistence will be paid at a rate of \$12.09/day of travel or the current min. subsistence amount published in the Federal Register, to a maximum of

\$51/day or the current max. amount published in the Federal Register to workers with receipts. The employer guarantees to offer work for hours equal to at least 3/4 of the work hours in each 12-week period of the total employment period, beginning with the first work day after the arrival of the worker at the place of employment and ending on the expiration date specified in this job order or its extension, if any. The employer may include all hours actually worked as well as any hours offered consistent with the job order that a worker chooses to not work, up to the maximum number of daily hours on the job order.
